

#### From The Pastor's Desk...

Spring has certainly been in the air. Locally, a record total rainfall for April has been recorded. All the flora and fauna are thriving! Flowering trees and shrubs have flowered earlier than usual, of course, and have given us beautiful color earlier than usual. Nature is treating us to spectacular reminders of the glory of God's creation!

On the human side of creation, things are not as pleasing or beautiful. A war rages in Gaza and hospitals continue to be among the targets. A sort of "scorched earth" strategy continues. The term "scorched earth" is a name of a strategy created in another war, several decades ago, in Southeast Asia. Both then and now, application of this military strategy, generates deaths of thousands of non-combatants.

The war against the repression pursued by Russia continues as well. Once again targets thought to be safe by virtue of long standing international law have been enthusiastically attacked by Russia. The deaths of innocents are an outcome.

For those of us blessed to live in this country, we have had the luxury of being able to believe the kind of violence, destruction, turmoil, and death played out in Gaza, Israel, the Ukraine, are at a safe distance.

But turmoil from these distant spots has arrived here. Palestinian and Israeli differences have become concrete on some of our college campuses. Members of the U. S. Congress have criticized a free democratic participatory nation in favor of the opinions of a Soviet dictatorship.


